# APPENDIX C Truck Route Survey Summary





This Appendix summarizes the compiled truck survey responses for the City of Sharon Truck Route Plan. All survey data was reviewed and incorporated, as applicable, into the assessment of existing truck route conditions and the development of truck route improvements. Conclusions and recommendations based on this data are documented in the final report. Summary survey data in this Appendix includes the following:

#### Survey Dates

Surveys were distributed during the month of April 2007, with a proposed response deadline of April 30, 2007. Responses were received and compiled thorough the end of May 2007.

#### Number and Types of Surveys

A total of 43 surveys of 3 different types were distributed to businesses throughout the study area. This total included 13 "Establishment Surveys" or "Transportation Provider Surveys", as appropriate, to large businesses having significant trucking operations, and 30 "Business Surveys" to smaller businesses and/or those having minor or minimal trucking operations.

#### Survey Participants and Responses

Survey participants and response rates are tabulated on the following page. Compiled responses, including respondent addresses, truck travel summaries, and additional comments (if any), are listed on pages 3-7 of this Appendix.

Provide truck route for permitted overweight loads from Duferco that avoids Pitt Street / Sharpsville Avenue corner.

Look into alternate truck route to Clark Street via Railroad Street and Shenango Avenue.

Finally, the number of trucks per day as listed represent present levels. Future levels (1-2 year period) could be 50-60% greater.

**TYPICAL NORTHERN ROUTE(S)** 










**TYPICAL EASTERN ROUTE(S)**

**TYPICAL WESTERN ROUTE(S)** 








