Notice is hereby given that Mercer County and the entitlement communities of Greenville Borough, Grove City Borough, Pine Township, and Sharpsville Borough will conduct a public hearing at 2:00 PM on Thursday, September 17, 2026. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain citizen views and comments on the County's proposed use of \$711,958 in Federal Fiscal Year 2026 CDBG funds which includes the entitlements allocations and to receive any complaints or grievances regarding the County's CDBG funds. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency.
